- Academic History: upload unofficial transcript(s)
- Program Selection
- Program Requirements

- Application Questions
 - Match code number
 - Three Short Answer Essays
 - Relevant Experiences or Coursework (maximum of 10)
 - Language Proficiency: other than English (optional)
 - Geographic Limitations (optional)
 - Prerequisite Courses
 - Prerequisite and/or GPA Context (optional)

- Application Materials: upload personal statement
- Recommendations: enter contact information for three recommenders
- English Language Proficiency (non-native English speakers only)
- Verify and Confirm: Social Security Number, Accuracy Statement, and Release of Materials Statement
- Review: make sure all required sections have been filled out
- UW application fee or apply for fee waiver
- Submit your application by **11:59 PM PT on December 6, 2024!**

Remember, *you do not need to finish your application in one sitting*. You can save it and come back to it. Take your time, be thorough, do not rush.
