- Register for the [Genetic Counseling Admissions Match](#) first. You must be registered for the Match in order for your application to be considered and to be ranked by programs. If you want a **fee waiver** for the Match, [apply for the fee waiver](#) *before* you register with the Match.

Complete our online application, including the following:

- Profile Information
- Contact Information
- Ethnicity Information (optional)
- Academic History: upload unofficial transcript(s)
- Program Selection
- Program Requirements

- Application Questions
 - Match code number
 - Three Short Answer Essays
 - Relevant Experiences or Coursework (maximum of 10)
 - Language Proficiency: other than English (optional)
 - Geographic Limitations (optional)
 - Prerequisite Courses: only list the course or course series that meets the minimum requirement for the prerequisite
 - Prerequisite and/or GPA Context (optional)

- Application Materials: upload personal statement (DO NOT include resume or CV)
- Recommendations: enter contact information for three recommenders (use the EXCLUDE option if you accidentally end up with more than 3 recommendations)
- English Language Proficiency (non-native English speakers only)
- Verify and Confirm: Social Security Number, Accuracy Statement, and Release of Materials Statement
- Review: make sure all required sections have been filled out
- UW application fee or apply for fee waiver
- Submit your application by **11:59 PM PT on December 5, 2025!**

Remember, *you do not need to finish your application in one sitting*. You can save it and come back to it. Take your time, be thorough, and do not rush.
